6. Statement of the purpose of the corporation

The purposes of the Corporation are:

1. To spread further and disseminate the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ through evangelical mission work and organization in the Country of Canada.
2. To preach the Gospel by radio broadcasting or television of Christian programs, publishing of printed material for spiritual education, training and teaching, as well as for publicizing the work of the organization, to establish Bible Schools as are deemed necessary for the accomplishment of spiritual training in Canada and by such other means as may be deemed desirable by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
3. To receive and accept donations, contributions and gifts of any and every kind in each or whatsoever whether by way of free will offerings, bequests, devises, gifts, contributions and gifts for the accomplishing in trying out of the purposes of the Corporation.
