Mobilization Report Jan 12, 2020

In October a team made up of the three field directors was formed to give direction to InterAct's mobilization efforts. Since that time the team has put a system in place that will insure that people inquiring about ministry with InterAct are followed up with a phone call within 48 hours. As well, everyone who shows significant interest will be in relationship with at least two people in InterAct, our 'warm voice' person (Sally Cross) and the field director of the field they are interested in. These people will be in regular contact with the potential missionary in order to build relationship, answer questions, offer opportunities to serve, and pray with the candidate as they seek God's will.

The team has also selected 13 Bible colleges in North America that InterAct will have a presence in through a recruiter visit at least twice a year and, in some of the schools, through George Walker's ability as a speaker and modular instructor. There are six other schools the team will be evaluating to determine if we should continue recruiting in those schools or not.

One of the Canada field missionaries, Andy (& Jesi) Chinn, is considering taking on the Mobilization Director role. Andy and Jesi are moving to Alberta at the beginning of April to be part of the leadership team for Canada's *EnGage!* summer ministry. If the Lord continues to lead they will then move into the Mobilization Director role and work with the mobilization team as well as learning some of the recruitment ropes from Jim Hamilton in the fall of 2020.

The recruitment pipeline below charts the timeline for potential candidates and gives a frame of reference for the mobilization team as we walk with people from early interest to serving on one of the ministry fields.
